Rathore, Member (J)</u></b> <b><u>Hon'ble Air Marshal BBP Sinha, Member (A)</u></b></p> <p>This is an application for review of order dated 9.01.2018 moved under Rule 18 of the Armed Forces Tribunal (Procedure) Rules, 2008, relevant portion of which is reproduced as under:</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">“ 18. Application for review. – (1) No application for review shall be entertained unless it is filed within thirty day from the date of receipt of copy of the order sought to be reviewed.</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">(2) -----“</p> <p>A Plain reading of Rule 18 (1) (supra) shows that no application for review shall be entertained after expiry of thirty days from the date of receipt of copy of the order.</p> <p>Ld.
