**ORDER(ORAL**

1. Heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the record.
2. In terms of order dated 26.10.2015, learned counsel for the respondents has not received instructions.
3. With the consent of learned counsel for the parties, we dispose of the M.A. at the initial stage.
4. Submission of learned counsel for the applicant is that the statutory complaint submitted by the applicant seems to be pending. Further submission of learned counsel for the applicant is the applicant suffer from jaundice and was incapable of joining for a period of two months and after recovery he reported at the centre, but was permitted to resume.
5. Without entering into the merits of the controversy involved in the case, we direct the respondents to dispose of the statutory complaint dated 26.09.2014. The applicant shall approach the appropriate authority with a certified copy of this order along with copies of statutory complaint dated 26.09.2014 and a fresh complaint along with supporting documents addressing all his grievances within one month from today. The respondents shall thereafter proceed to decide the statutory complaint of the applicant within next three months by a speaking and reasoned order and communicate decision to the applicant.
6. With the aforesaid direction, the M.A. is disposed of finally.
