ORDER(ORAL)

1. Heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the record.
2. The applicant has approached this Tribunal under Section 14 of the Armed Forces Tribunal Act, 2007 being aggrieved by the impugned order of discharge dated 22.09.2015. Learned counsel for the respondents submitted that the statutory complaint submitted by the applicant shall be disposed of within six months.
3. In these circumstances, with the consent of learned counsel for the parties, we dispose of this application at the admission stage itself.
4. The competent authority is directed to decide the statutory complaint preferred by the applicant expeditiously, say within a period of three months from the date of presentation of a certified copy of this order along with a copy of the earlier statutory complaint by a reasoned and speaking order and communicate the decision to the applicant.
5. Subject to above directions, we dispose of the O.A. finally.
6. No order as to costs.
