

**PROGRAMME FOR INTERNSHIP FOR L.L.B./L.L.M./**  
**RESEARCH STUDENTS**

The Armed Forces Tribunal, Regional Bench, Lucknow provides opportunities by holding Summer Internship Programme (in the month of July) and Winter Internship Programme (in the month of December/January ordinarily).

The Programme is open for students pursuing studies in Law from recognized Colleges/Law Schools/Universities in India.

**GUIDELINES OF THE PROGRAMME**

1. Duration of Internship will be four 4 weeks ordinarily.
2. The Armed Forces Tribunal, Regional Bench, Lucknow pays no remuneration/ expenses.
3. The interested law students pursuing three-years and five-years law degree course from any recognized College/Law School/University may send their applications in the enclosed format, by 1<sup>st</sup> February (in case of Summer Internship Programme) and by 1<sup>st</sup> October (in case of Winter Internship Programme).
4. These applications may be sent either by post, or by hand in prescribed format to reach the office of the Registrar, Armed Forces Tribunal, Regional Bench, Lucknow, 3, R.A.K. Marg, Lucknow-226002. Applications can also be mailed at [aftlko32@gmail.com](mailto:aftlko32@gmail.com). Application received after the last date may not be considered and no correspondence will be entertained in this regard. Incomplete application will not be entertained.
5. All these applications will be scrutinized and the actual offer will be sent to the selected students subject to the availability of slot and approval of the Competent Authority. Maximum number of slots to be offered to the students shall be decided by the Competent Authority.
6. The students will have to produce a recommendation/no-objection letter from their Director or Head of Department, after receiving intimation from this office. A guide will be assigned to each intern for their study during internship.
7. Interns will be required to present a research paper/report on a selected topic at the end of their study and also undergo other studies assigned and prepare notes on it and submit to the concerned officer for evaluation and suggestions, if any, by the Tribunal. It will remain as intellectual property of the Tribunal and interns cannot use it without prior approval of the Tribunal.
8. A certificate will be issued to the Intern at the end of her/his internship after evaluation of the research paper or assessment of the work done. Duration and timing of internship may be altered by the Competent Authority as and when necessary.
9. The internship may be discontinued anytime if the performance of the interns is not found satisfactory or the intern is absent without authorization of the guide.
