ORDER

1. Being aggrieved with non adjustment of post discharge claims i.e. Children Education Allowance (CEA), Compensation in Lieu of Quarters (CILQ) and 10 days Leave Encashment (LTC), applicant has filed this O.A. under Section 14 of the Armed Forces Tribunal Act, 2007.
2. Brief facts of the case are that applicant was enrolled in the Army on 16.07.1997 and he was discharged from service w.e.f. 31.07.2016 (AN) after completion of terms of engagements. On account of certain pending dues, applicant submitted representations dated 28.07.2016 and 15.06.2019 (Annexure No A-4) requesting respondents to adjust amount related to CEA, CILQ and 10 days LTC.
3. The respondents have filed counter affidavit. In counter affidavit para 7 clearly states that Rs 11,917.00, Rs 14,400.00 and Rs 44,460.00 have been paid to the applicant in the month of March, 2019 and there is nothing pending to be paid to applicant.
4. During the course of hearing on 02.01.2024, applicant has filed supplementary affidavit conceding therein that relief claimed has been granted and this O.A. be disposed off.
5. Since relief claimed has already been granted, with the consent of learned counsel for the parties, this O.A. is disposed off.
6. No order as to costs.
7. Miscellaneous application(s), pending if any, stand disposed of.
